According to the Census Bureau’s latest report (March 2018), “The year 2030 marks a demographic turning point for the United States.” The report notes, “Beginning that year, all baby boomers will be older than 65. 21 percent of the entire population will be on Medicare, Social Security or, in most cases, both. In 2035, the number of 65-and-overs will surpass the number of Americans under 18 for the first time in the nation’s history.”

At Home In Darien is at the forefront in planning for this pivotal time.

AT HOME IN DARIEN SENIOR STORY...

Of the 3,273 seniors in Darien, we’d like to share the story of just one of them. This is what At Home In Darien means to Mary, who is kind and good-natured, and while in her late 80’s, enjoys keeping active. Mary and her husband, who passed on several years ago, raised their children in Darien. Her roots are deep, as is her love for this town.

Mary calls At Home In Darien for referrals to vetted service providers such as plumbers, landscapers, and electricians. We also arrange for volunteers to lend a hand with small items like changing batteries in smoke alarms and taking air conditioners in and out of windows, and to assist with leaf raking and removing snow from her public sidewalk. Once, after a particularly large snowfall, we were able to send someone to her home to get the mail from her mailbox because she couldn’t get there safely!

Recently, Mary had some serious health issues. With all of her grown children out of town, she called for a volunteer driver to accompany her to an important medical appointment and was delighted with the

experience. She’s come to trust us and knows we are here to help when she needs us.

Although Mary gave up driving, she continues to be involved and active with rides from At Home In Darien’s professional drivers. She says the drivers are friendly and polite and that her children are “all very relieved that I have transportation and can get out of the house.”

When speaking about her volunteer visitor and shopper, Mary grinned. “We’ve all become really good friends. They call me to ask how I am, it’s so nice.”

We asked Mary what impact it would have on her if At Home In Darien wasn’t here to give her a ride. “I’d have to move. I’d have nothing. Especially now that I can’t drive (At Home In Darien) is all I have to connect me to (places I go).” Mary knows we are available to take her wherever she wants to go. We help her maintain her independence. “Without At Home In Darien I don’t think I’d be able to stay here in Darien”.






